POLICY STATEMENT

Xceler8 Constructions Pty Ltd works on road, bridge, pipeline and drainage infrastructure, often adjacent to live waterways, stormwater networks and sensitive receptors. Concrete, form release agents, fuels, slurry, dust and noise all have the potential to cause environmental harm if they are not controlled.

Xceler8 Constructions accepts its general environmental duty under section 319 of the Environmental Protection Act 1994 (Qld): we will not carry out any activity that causes, or is likely to cause, environmental harm unless we take all reasonable and practicable measures to prevent or minimise that harm.

OUR COMMITMENTS

Xceler8 Constructions commits to:

- Complying with the Environmental Protection Act 1994 and Regulation 2019, associated policies for water, air, noise and waste, local government requirements, and the environmental conditions imposed by the principal contractor and the project approval.
- Identifying environmental aspects and impacts for each work package before work starts, and building the controls into the Environmental Management Plan and the relevant SWMS.
- Preventing concrete, wash water, slurry, fuels and chemicals from entering waterways, stormwater inlets and drainage lines — designated washout bays only, bunded storage, spill kits available at every work front.
- Controlling erosion and sediment in accordance with the project ESC plan, and inspecting controls before and after rain events.
- Managing dust, including respirable crystalline silica, at the source using water suppression, on-tool extraction and no dry sweeping.
- Minimising waste, segregating recyclable materials, and disposing of regulated waste through licensed carriers to licensed facilities.
- Managing noise and vibration within approved hours and limits, and consulting the principal contractor before any out-of-hours works.
- Reporting all environmental incidents and near misses, investigating them, and closing out corrective actions.
- Setting environmental objectives and targets, monitoring performance, and reviewing this system at least annually.

No concrete, wash water, slurry, fuel or chemical is permitted to enter a waterway or stormwater system at any time.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Director — provides the resources for environmental controls and holds ultimate accountability for the company's environmental performance.

Supervisors and Foremen — implement the Environmental Management Plan and project environmental conditions on site, inspect controls, and stop work where environmental harm is occurring or imminent.

Workers and subcontractors — follow the environmental controls in the SWMS and EMP, use the designated washout and storage areas, and report spills and environmental incidents immediately.

Any spill, discharge or environmental incident is to be contained where safe to do so and reported to the Xceler8 Constructions Supervisor and the principal contractor immediately.
